FINAL DIAGNOSES: TERM BIRTH, FEMALE.
 BILATERAL CLEFT PALATE, BILATERAL CLAWED HANDS, BILATERAL
 CLAWED FEET.

SUMMARY:

Heather is the product of a 21-year-old A-negative gravida I, para 0, mother, 41⁺ weeks gestation, spontaneous delivery, uncomplicated, Apgars 9 and 10, birth weight 7 lbs. 0 o

At birth it was noted that the infant had bilateral cleft palate and lip and clawed hands and feet; no other congenital anomalies noted; otherwise the child was normal. Consultation was obtained with Doctor Magdi Kodosi, plastic surgeon, who referred the child to St. Christopher's hospital for correction of her multiple defects and for physical therapy and supportive care.

Of note was the fact that the child attempted to breast feed, but the mother was unsuccessful with the breast feeding and she was switched to Similac with iron and was discharged on that. The child will be followed in our office and at St. Christopher's Hospital.
